


USS Midway Tour - \$45.00 per person

Welcome to the impressive 1001 foot USS Midway. On Saturday, January 10, 2004, the majestic Midway made her final journey from North Island Naval Station, across the bay to her final berth at the Navy Pier. Commissioned in 1945, she served proudly until 1992 during the Korean War, Vietnam and the Persian Gulf. She also served as the naval flagship during Operation Desert Storm in 1991. The lead ship of her class, she was the first aircraft carrier built that was too large to pass through the Panama Canal. She inspired all who served on her and now her "Midway Magic" continues to inspire visitors from around the world and chronicle the achievements and sacrifice of those who defended our nation.

Historic Old Town Walking Tour - \$40.00 per person

Old Town San Diego State Historic Park recreates life in the Mexican and early American periods of 1821 to 1872. It is called the Birthplace of California because it was the first European settlement on the West Coast. Five original adobes are part of the complex, which includes shops, restaurants and a museum. Now, 37 historic buildings demonstrate the early pueblo period. On your personally guided walking tour, you'll explore the lifestyles of the Mexican and American pioneers. Experience the days of the dons at La Casa de Estudillo, an adobe mansion built around a garden courtyard. Sit in the desks of San Diego's first public school at the Mason Street School House. Visit The Whaley House Museum Complex, a park consisting of five historic buildings including the famous Thomas Whaley House, believed by many to be the most haunted house in America. Discover a world of shopping unlike any other at Bazaar del Mundo! Amidst sun-splashed gardens and spirited mariachis, you'll find bright, bold and beautiful treasures specially selected from around the world for their exceptional quality and inspiration.



An Afternoon at the San Diego Zoo - \$75.00 per person
